COMMENTS:	The Texas Fatality Operational Response System (TFORS) is a volunteer group of medical and forensic personnel, usually from the same geographic region, who have formed a response team under the guidance of the Texas Disaster Medical System, and whose personnel have specific training/skills in victim identification, mortuary services, and forensic pathology and anthropology methods.								
	Note 1: Standard TFORS has 31 personnel plus basic load of equipment. Usually includes a mix of medical examiners, coroners, pathologists, forensic anthropologists, medical records technicians, fingerprint technicians, forensic odentologists, dental assistants, radiologists, funeral directors, mental health professionals, and support personnel.								
	Note 2: TFORSs are mission tailored on an ad hoc basis, and usually deploy only with personnel and equipment specifically required for current mission.								
	Note 3: There is currently one Portable Morgue Units within TDMS.
