Dispatch Side Tab

1. Call Source (Usually Fire Department /EMS Agency)
2. Incident# is Armband Number
3. Nature of Call (if determined)
4. Trauma or Medical (if determined)
5. Pick-Up Address (Use pull down of Common Locations) then hit "Tab"

Times Side Tab

6. Call Received (Pt Arrival/Triage Time)

Patient Tab

7. Patient Name
8. Gender
9. DOB

Outcome Tab

10. Outcome (TDMS Treated/Released or TDMS Treated/Transferred)
